- Disposable Cameras
- Global Phone Calling Cards (AT&T are most flexible for use anywhere)
- Handheld electronic games
- Puzzle, Word Game and Crossword books
- Commercially wrapped individual packets of Trail Mix, Beef Jerky, Nuts, (NO PORK PRODUCTS)
- Cookies, Energy Bars, Sunflower Seeds, Candy (please do not send chocolate because it melts)
- Ready To Eat Tuna or Chicken Salad kits
- Boxes of Girl Scout Cookies
- Packets of Powdered Cold Beverages
- Individual servings of coffee (coffee singles), cocoa or tea (also sugar and creamer packets)
- Commercially sealed Lip Balm
- Individual packets of moist towelettes
- Packets of Stationery
- Novelty Items (Slinkies, Toy Planes, etc.)
- Individual oatmeal packets
- New T-shirts (sizes Large and Extra Large) and Socks
- Unsealed personal cards and letters
- Small size toothpaste, deodorant & talcum/foot powder
- Playing Cards
- Liquid body soap (Small size bottles)
- Cold tablets (Blister pack)
- Skin lotion
- Sunblock (SPF30)
- Eye drops
- Blankets
- Magazines (Car, Sports and Financial)
- Dryer Sheets
- Insect repellent (Towelette types are best)
- Bandanas (Camouflage if possible)
- Boot insoles
